#### A BRIEF NOTE ON

### TWENTY POINT PROGRAMME -2006

- > Twenty Point Programme (TPP) was launched by the Government of India in the year 1975 and restructured in 1982, 1986 and again in 2006, known as Twenty Point Programme (TPP)-2006, became operational w.e.f. 1st April, 2007. The Programme is meant to give a thrust to schemes relating to Poverty Alleviation, Employment Generation in Rural Areas, Housing, Education, Family Welfare & Health, Protection of Environment and many other dimensions having a bearing on the quality of life, especially in the rural areas.
- ➤ Twenty Point Programme (TPP)-2006 covers 65 items including about 162 Parameters out of which 15 items consisting of 20 parameters are monitored on monthly basis against pre-set targets.
- For the purpose of evaluation, the performance of States under TPP-2006 in respect of 15 items viz (i) Individual Swarozgaries Assisted under SGSY/NRLM, (ii) SHGs to whom income generating activities provided; (iii) Food Security TPDS, (APL, BPL and AAY); (iv) Rural Housing Indira Awaas Yojana; (v) EWS/LIG Houses in Urban Areas; (vi) Habitations covered (Partially Covered and Slipped back)-NRDWP, Coverage of Water Quality Affected Habitation- NRDWP (vii) SC Family Assisted- under SCA to SCSP and NSFDC, SC Family Assisted-SC students assisted under post matric scholarship (viii) Universalisation of ICDS Scheme; (ix) Functional Anganwadis (x) Number of Urban poor families assisted under seven point charter (xi) Area covered under Plantation (Public & Forest lands), Seedlings Planted-(Public & Forest lands), (xii) Rural Roads-PMGSY; (xiii) Rajiv Gandhi Grameen Vidutikaran Yojana RGGVY; (xiv) Energizing Pump sets (xv) Supply of Electricity have been taken into account.
- Although in the State of Punjab work regarding this programme has enthrusted to the Department of Programme Implementations but this assignment is being performed by the officers/officials of the Economic & Statistical Organization, Punjab in addition to their own duties. This department regularly monitors the financial/physical progress of the schemes implement by the different departments. The quarterly progress reports received from various departments are securitized and consolidated report is being sent to Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MOSPI) GOI. For effective implementation of this programme State level, District Level and Block Level Monitoring Committees has already been constituted. The reconstitution of these committees is under consideration of Govt.
