### **ITEM 3 Pending Complaint (District Jalandhar)**

Sh. Avinash Rai Khanna Hon'ble MP Rajya Sabha recommended work for "Construction of Streets and Installation of Sewerage System in village Hussainpur District Jalandhar. It was sanctioned by District Authority (DA) without verification of title of land. Later on a complaint was sent by Sh. Satish Kumar and Smt. Sukhvinder Kaur Sarpanches Lambra and Hussainpur villages to MOSPI that the land on which said work was done is private. On the direction of MOSPI, an enquiry was conducted and Commissioner Jalandhar Division sent a report that the land is actual was private and responsibility of Xen and SDO Panchayati Raj was fixed who are responsible for this lapse. MOSPI further directed that money should be recouped. DA has not recouped the money till date despite reminders.

**Action: Worthy CS may direct DC Jalandhar to recoupe the money and send ATR to MOSPI as well as State Headquarter.**

### **ITEM 4 Enforcement of Provisions for development of SC/ST areas**

As per MPLADS guidelines MPs are to recommend every year works costing at least 15 % of MPLADS funds for areas inhabited by SC population and 7.5 % of the areas inhabited by ST Population. As there is no ST population in the State, 22.50% of the funds are to be sanctioned for SC areas.

**Action: DCs to ensure that funds amounting to 22.50% are sanctioned for SC areas.**

### **ITEM 5 Third Party Physical Monitoring – MPLADS works:**

Agricultural Finance Corporation (AFC) has made Third Partly Physical monitoring in District Sangrur, Pathankot, Shri Muktsar Sahib, Moga, Faridkot, SBS Nagar & Hoshiarpur. The Physical monitoring reports were sent to concerned DC's to send Action Taken Report to MOSPI. All DC's except DC Shri. Muktsar Sahib has sent Action Taken Report to Ministry.

**Action: DC Shri Muktsar Sahib to send Action Taken Report to MOSPI immediately.**

### **ITEM 6 Inspection Reports at District level**

District Authorities to inspect at least 10% of works under implementation every year. District authorities should involve the MPs in inspections of projects to the extent feasible. No reports are being received from District Authorities.
