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Manual No.I The particulars of its organisation, functions and duties.

The main functions of this Organisation are as under:-

- I. To advise the State Government on Economic and statistical matters for formulation of policies and plans.
- II. To coordinate statistical activities of various departments in the state.
- III. To collect, compile, analyse and interpret Economic and Statistical data and act as data bank.
- IV. To conduct analytical and evaluation studies and surveys.
- V. To keep a proper liaison with the Central Statistical Organisation, Govt. of India and other State Statistical Bureaus of the country.
- VI. District level offices of Economic & Statistical Organisation, Punjab are also providing secretariat services to District Planning Committees apart from collection and compilation of primary as well as secondary data and its onward transmission to head office. Economic & Statistical Organisation, Punjab is the nodal agency for handling the progress of work under MPLAD.

With the advent of the era of Economic planning and development, the State Govt. created a statistical office headed by the Economic & Statistical Advisor in 1949 to cater to the statistical needs of the state. The Board of Economic inquiry too became a part and parcel of this office in 1953. Similarly, Board of Economic inquiry/bureau of Economic and Statistics was created in 1949/1950 in erstwhile Pepsu State. With the merger of Punjab and Pepsu in 1956, the present Economic & Statistical Organisation (E.S.O) came into being. With the passage of time and extension of more developmental and planned activities, the E.S.O. was strengthened.

Economic and Statistical Organisation, Punjab makes a major contribution in strengthening the data base of the State and has been declared Nodal Agency since 8.4.2003 for effective coordination of statistical activities of all the departments and create common statistical cadre in Punjab. The Statistical needs of private sector are also met by this Organisation. The Planners, Research scholars, social thinkers and

administrators heavily draw upon the statistical information available with this Department. The data collected by the Organisation highlights the level of socio-Economic development of the State. This data helps in formulation and evaluation of Development Programmes of state and identifies different bottlenecks in these programmes for taking corrective measures for proper development of the state.

The Collection of Statistics Act, 2008 has been enacted from 6th June, 2010 by Govt. of India to improve the credibility and timeliness of official statistics. Prior to this act, there were few acts such as Labour Act, Birth and Death Registration Act, Census Act etc. under which specific statistics were collected and these acts did not cover all types of statistics. The Collection of Statistics Act, 2008 covers all type of statistics Govt. of Punjab vide notification No-17255 dated 14.10. 2011 has designated Economic Adviser, Govt. of Punjab as a Nodal Officer for exercising powers and performing duties under this act.

The Organisation is headed by Economic Adviser who is assisted by Directors, Joint Directors, Deputy ESAs, Research Officers and Assistant Research Officers. There is a District Statistical Office in each of the district of the State headed by Deputy Economic and Statistical Adviser.

The Organisation has 20 sections including establishment section at the State Head Quarter. The establishment section manages the human resource administration and is manned by Superintendents, Senior Assistants, Clerks and typists.

Other 19 sections in the Economic & Statistical Organisation, Punjab engage in the specialized fields are given below:-

I. State Income:-

This section is engaged in the preparation of estimates of State Domestic Product (SDP). The estimation of State Domestic Product for the financial year are prepared both at current and at constant prices for all the fifteen sectors of the Economy and estimates of per capita income are also prepared regularly with a time lag of two years. Quick estimates of SDP (State Domestic Product) based on production targets of Agriculture, Livestock and Fishing sectors and past trend in respect of other sectors are prepared annually with a time lag of one year. Sectoral estimates of SDP at current and at constant prices are also prepared for all the districts regularly with a time gap of two years. Sector wise growth rates of SDP for different periods are also prepared. Notes on Economic situation in the State and comparative position of the State vis-a-vis other States with respect to State Income Estimates are also prepared for the use of the State Government.

II. Public Finance:-

The main function of Public Finance Section is to prepare Economic and Functional Classification of the State Government and Municipal Committees/Corporations budgetary transactions. The data are compiled, processed and presented in three annual publications. The publication, "Economic and Functional classification of State Government Budget," highlights the Economic and functional impact of the budgetary operations of the State Government. Other publications are. "An Economic and Functional Classification of Municipal Budgets in Punjab" and "Statistics of Public Finance."

III. Capital Formation:-

The estimates of Gross state Domestic capital formation of all the sectors of Economy at current as well as constant prices for both public and private sectors are prepared so as to study the investment pattern in the state. Since it is an important indicator for infrastructure development, the estimates are used while formulating the development plans.

IV. Employment:-

The main function of this section is to determine the impact on direct and indirect employment generated with the establishment of various industrial, irrigation and power projects in Punjab State. One project is selected and the study thereof is undertaken at a time to assess the impact on direct and indirect employment in the command area of the project.

V. Industry:-

Data on industrial production especially in the un-registered sector in the State are very scanty. The Annual Survey of Industries (ASI) which covers only the registered sector collects data on production in different groups of Industries in the State. The data collected by the ASI have been used for preparation of Index Number of Industrial production. These indices show an overall trend in the Industrial production as well as production trend at industrial groups, sub-groups and item levels in physical terms. The indices also show growth/decline in the registered industrial sector of the State.

VI. Tabulation :-

This section tabulates data of the National Sample Surveys. This section deals with compilation of the State Sample data collected from the field. Processing and Tabulation

of data is done in accordance with the procedure and tabulation plan supplied by the National Sample Surveys Organisation, Government of India.

VII. Plan Evaluation:-

Plan Evaluation Section is engaged in evaluating the various Programs/Schemes of different departments of the State Government. These evaluation reports help the Planners and Administrators to assess the performance of projects/programs/schemes for its impact on the area/people for which these are designed. The topics for evaluation are selected by the State Evaluation Committee under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary.

VIII. Compilation:-

This section works as the data bank in respect of official statistics on various subjects. State Statistical Abstract prepared by the section is released alongwith the annual Budget of State Government. A wide range of data made available comprehensively in this publication, is very useful for the state administrators, planners, and researchers etc.

IX. Prices:-

For studying the behaviour of prices especially under inflationary pressures, whole-sale and retail prices are collected and published in Prices Bulletins. Consumer Price Index Numbers for working class are prepared for Six centres viz. Phagwara, Dhariwal, Patiala, Abohar, Bathinda and Nangal and supplied to State Govt. These indices are being used for providing dearness relief to the industrial workers.

X. Field Operation:-

This section is primarily engaged in collection of primary data at village and block level on various important socio-Economic aspects which hitherto is not collected by any other agency. The data is in great demand from various Government departments and organisation especially for the purpose of decentralised and grass root planning. Detailed village-wise information collected by Investigators posted at the block level is maintained in the Village Directory, Block at a glance and Indicators of Socio-Economic Development for each district of the State. Ad-hoc Surveys are also conducted by this section as per requirement of the State Government.

XI. Demography

This section interpolates population data for inter-census period and also extrapolates it for the post census years. These data are used by different departments and institutions.

Census of Punjab Government employees (number of employees belonging to Scheduled Castes/Tribe/Backward Classes, wards of freedom fighters and ex-servicemen employees) conducted every year provide department-wise, class-wise and pay range-wise statistics of Govt. employees. Information regarding prices of building material and wage rates of construction labour engaged in construction activity is collected quarter-wise from all District headquarters in Punjab State and transmitted to National Building Organisation (Ministry of Housing, Government of India). Besides this, the Building Construction Cost Index is also sent to N.B.O. The Index is an important indicator which reflects the trend in building construction cost. These indices show variations in prices over time and help in evaluating construction costs.

XII. Irrigation

Irrigation section collects and co-ordinates statistics on different aspect of irrigation, flood control and power in the State.

XIII. Farm Accounts

This section deals with farm accounts and family budgets of selected cultivators in the state which reveal how much a cultivator gains out of production and how much he spends on farming.

XIV. National Sample Survey

The National Sample Surveys (NSS) unit works in collaboration with the National Sample Surveys Organisation (NSSO), Government of India. This unit conducts sample Surveys for collecting various types of data required by the Central Ministries, State Departments, Planning Commission and other interested Organisations. The subject for surveys are finalised by the Governing Council of N.S.S.O., Government of India. Sample Surveys conducted by this unit follow a uniform pattern prescribed for all the States in the country under the guidance of N.S.S.O.

XV. Training

Junior staff of the Economic & Statistical Organisation, Punjab is given training on various activities of the department.

XVI. Art

The art section prepares various displaying charts, maps, pictograms and other visual aids for various publications.

XVII. India Statistical Strengthening Project

This section is engaged in the handling of India Statistical Strengthening. This project has been launched as a centrally sponsored scheme by Govt. of India as a follow up of recommendations of Rangarajan Commission report- 2001. The main objective of this project is to strengthen the State Statistical System. Under this project a Letter of Participation (LOP) has been signed by State Govt with Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MOSPI), Govt. of India to implement the project in State. As per the LOP the States will, inter-alia, prepare " State Strategic Statistical Plan (SSSP)" on the basis of which Govt of India (GOI) will provide grant to State Govt for reforming the Statistical System.

XVIII. Economic Census

Sixth Economic Census 2012-13 in the State is being conducted along-with other States and Union Territories of India in collaboration with the Registrar General of India under a Centrally Sponsored Scheme, the guidelines for which are provided by C.S.O.Govt.of India.

The aim and objective of this scheme, is to update the list of establishments and to fill in the data gaps relating to distribution and Economic characteristics of establishments and to collect data regarding structure, nature of activities and number of persons normally working in all the enterprises. It envisages to conduct a census of all the agricultural (excluding production of agricultural crops and plantation) and non-agricultural enterprises.

XIX. MPLADS

This section is engaged in handling and monitoring all works relating to MP Local Area Development Scheme and all District Offices have been assigned this work in the respective districts.

XX. 20 Point Programme

This section engaged in handling and monitoring all works relating to 20 point program in the State.

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Manual II The powers and duties of its officers and employees

The powers and duties of the Officers of E.S.O., Punjab are as under:-

- 1 **Economic Adviser** enjoys the powers of Head of the Department as well as Head of the Office laid down in the Service Rules P.F.R., Standing orders issued by the Govt. C.S.R. and in any other Rules/instructions etc. issued by the Government from time to time.
- 2 **Director (Admn.)** has been delegated some administrative powers by Economic Adviser to run the office smoothly .

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Manual III The procedure followed in the decision making process, Including channels of supervision and accountability;

This Office has no public dealing. It deals with the collection, compilation and analysis of primary as well as secondary data. The cases/P.U.Cs/subjects relating to the work are initiated by Statistical Assistants/Assistant Research Officers/ Research Officers and submitted to Deputy ESAs and further to Joint Directors and then to Directors which are disposed of at the level of Economic Adviser, Secretary Planning, Minister-in-charge, and Chief Minister as per standing orders. (Annexure- I to V).

2. In the Establishment and Accounts Branch the PUCs/files or proposals are initiated by Clerks/Dealing Assistants with reference to the relevant rules/instructions framed/issued by the Department/Government on the subject from time to time and submitted to Branch Incharge in the ministerial side and the files are disposed off at the level of Head of the office, Head of the Department, Administrative Secretaries and Minister-in-Charge as per standing orders which are attached as Annexure-I to V.

However, such cases shall be shown to me on my return to headquarter.

3. Cases, which are not covered /mentioned in Annexure-I, II, III, IV and V shall be disposed of as per Rules of Business ibid.

Investigator is the only functionary at the block level. He is engaged in the collection of village/block-wise routine statistics to meet the requirement of the District Statistical Office as well as the Headquarter. This village level data is disseminated in the form of publication i.e. village Directory, Block at a glance. His services are also utilised for conducting the Ad-hoc Socio-Economic Surveys at the block level. The detailed data on essential items is also maintained at block level in the form of tables. The data is scrutinised by Statistical Assistant/Assistant Research Officer/District Statistical Officer at district level and transmitted to State Head Quarter. It is then further examined, rectified and published at Head Office.

The Department observes the norms set by the Department of Statistics and Programme Implementation, Govt. of India. The other branches at the Head Quarter also collect the various type of data and then this data is disseminated in the form of Annual publications.

The other Branches at the Headquarter prepare their annual data. The Department prepares the data in consultation with other Departments of the State like Revenue, Agriculture, Education, Health, Rural Development, Animal Husbandry and such other Departments. The Staff i.e. Research Officers, Assistant Research Officers, Statistical Assistants and Investigators make field visits as per requirement. They interview villagers/Village level functionaries of different Departments and collect data. The Department observes the norms set by the Department of Statistics & Programme Implementation.

An investigator is expected to collect information pertaining to the concerned Block during a year. Statistical Assistant checks the data collected by Investigators. Similarly, Assistant Research Officer/Research Officer makes test checks before finalizing the same.

As per the Punjab District Planning Committees Act, 2005 (copy enclosed) issued vide Notification No. 35-LEG/2005, dated 28.11.05, the District Planning Committees are to be constituted in each district of the State. The total number of members of the said committee have been calculated on the basis of population criteria given in sub-section (2) of Section 3 of the said Act, the detail of which is given below:-

3. The 1/5th number of members are to be nominated by the State Government. For the 4/5th of the members which are to be elected from amongst the Zila Parishad members and from members of the urban local bodies, you are requested to hold the elections in your district as per procedure given below and send the list of elected members to the Planning Department within 15 days so that the District Planning Committees may be constituted by the State Government at the earliest possible:-

3.1 For election of the members from rural areas, the Electoral College would consist of directly elected members of Zila Parishad. For election of members from urban areas, Electoral College would consist of directly elected members/ Councilors of Municipal Corporations/ Municipal Councils/Nagar Panchayats.

3.2 The Deputy Commissioner or any other officer appointed by him not below the rank of an Extra Assistant Commissioner would call a meeting of all the directly elected Zila Parishad members and a separate meeting of all directly elected members of the Urban Local Bodies (Municipal Corporations/Municipal Councils/Nagar Panchayats) for election of members to be taken on the District Planning Committees, from amongst them, after giving 7 days notice indicating therein the total number of members to be elected and time schedule for holding elections, as per specimen given in Form 3.2.

3.3 2/3rd of the total directly elected members would constitute a quorum for conducting the meeting for election.

3.4 When the members assemble at the time and place intimated to them as per time schedule given in Form 3.2, the Presiding Officer will supply them nomination form, (as per specimen given in Form 3.4) who may be willing to contest election for being members of the DPCs. The members would fill this form and hand it over to the Presiding Officer by the specified time.

3.5 The Presiding Officer will then conduct scrutiny of the nomination forms to ensure that the same are in order and as per electoral college.

3.6 Any member may withdraw his candidature by filling Form 3.6 which will be handed over by him to the Presiding Officer by the time specified in Form 3.2.

3.7 Immediately after the said process, the Presiding Officer will prepare the final list of contesting candidates and get it printed on the Column 2 of the ballot paper (specimen in Form 3.7).

3.8 If the total number of contesting candidates is less than or equal to the number of vacancies to be filled, there will be no election and all such members will be declared to be duly elected.

3.9 If the number of contesting candidates is more than the vacancies to be filled, the Presiding Officer would supply them a ballot paper (as per specimen in Form 3.7) which will be serial numbered and ask them to mark () against the name of the person to whom he wants to elect and mark (X) to whom he does not want to elect. The ballot

paper should be filled up by Presiding Officer except column No.3 against names of contesting candidates. At the time of issuing a ballot paper to a voter, the Presiding Officer will sign in full on the ballot paper, record the serial number thereof in the counterfoil of the ballot paper, put the official seal and also mark the name of the voter in the voter list.

3.10 After receiving the ballot paper, the voter would mark the necessary signs () or (X) on the ballot paper, fold it and insert it into the ballot box.

3.11 On the same day and at the time as per time schedule given in Form 3.2, the Presiding Officer will open the ballot box and count the number of ballot papers taken out there from.

3.12 The Presiding Officer will reject a ballot paper if it bears any mark or writing by which the voter can be identified; or if no vote is recorded thereon; or if voter is in favour of candidates more than the vacancies to be filled or if the mark indicated thereon is placed in such a manner as to make it doubtful to which candidates the vote has been given; or if it is spurious ballot paper; or if it does not bear both the official seal and the signature of the Presiding Officer.

3.13 After completion of counting, the Presiding Officer will record in a statement, the total number of votes polled by each candidate and announce the result.

3.14 If quorum of the meeting is not fulfilled and the meeting is adjourned, another meeting will be convened by the Presiding Officer by giving not less than 24 hours notice to the members. No quorum will be necessary for the adjourned meeting.

3.15 If, at the bottom, two or more members get the same number of votes, the matter will be decided by draw of lots.

3.16 The Deputy Commissioner would keep in safe custody all papers relating to the elections. However, on the expiry of six months from the date of publication of the names of the elected members of the District Planning Committee, all the papers relating to the election may be destroyed.

3.17 If any vacancy arises due to any reason, it will be filled up with the same procedure from the same source from which it has occurred.

3.18 If the total number of directly elected Zila Parishad/Urban Local Bodies members, as the case may be, is less than or equal to the number of vacancies to be filled, there will be no election and such members will be declared to be duly elected.

3.19 The Deputy Commissioner will send the list of elected candidates to the State Planning Department on the same day both by speed post as well as by Fax.

THE PUNJAB DISTRICT PLANNING COMMITTEES ACT, 2005
(Punjab Act No.22 of 2005)

An Act to provide for the constitution of the District Planning Committees with a view to consolidate the plans prepared by the Panchayats and the Municipalities in the districts and to prepare the draft development plans for the districts as a whole in the State and for the matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Punjab in the Fifty-sixth Year of the Republic of India.

3. (1) There shall be constituted a Committee to be called the District Planning Committee by the State Government for every district in the State to consolidate the plans prepared by the Panchayats and the Municipalities in the district and to prepare a draft development plan for the district as a whole.
- (2) The number of members of a District Planning Committee constituted under sub-section (1), shall be calculated as per population of the district concerned according to the following criteria, namely:-
- (a) District having population, Fifteen members
Not exceeding ten lacs;
 - (b) Districts having population Twenty four members
exceeding ten lacs, but not exceeding twenty lacs; and
 - (c) Districts having population Forty Members
exceeding twenty lacs.
- (3) The Chairperson of the Committee shall be chosen from amongst the members of the Committee by the State Government by nomination.
- (4) The seats of the members of the Committee shall be filled by election, from amongst the elected members of the Panchayat at the district level and of the Municipalities in the district, and by nomination.
- (5) Not less than four-fifths of the total number of members of the Committee shall be elected by, and from amongst the elected members of the Panchayat at the district level and of the Municipalities in the district in proportion to the ratio between the population of the rural areas and of the urban areas in the district.
- (6) One-fifth of the total number of members of the Committee, which may include the Members of the Legislative Assembly and other persons also, shall be nominated by the State Government.
- (7) The Deputy Commissioner of the district shall be the ex-officio Secretary of the Committee.
- (8) The Additional Deputy Commissioner (Development) of the district shall be the ex-officio Additional Secretary of the Committee.
- (9) The Deputy Economic & Statistical Adviser of the District shall be the ex-officio Joint Secretary of the Committee.

4. (1) The term of an elected member of Committee shall be co-terminus with the term of the Panchayat at the district level or a Municipality, as the case may be, of which he is a member.
- (2) The term of a nominated member including the Chairperson, shall be one year. However, a nominated member shall be eligible for re-nomination after the expiry of his first term.
- (3) Any member of the Committee including the Chairperson, may resign at any time from his office before his tenure.

5. (1) Subject to the provisions of this Act, the Committee shall exercise powers and perform. The functions as mentioned below:-

- a) to prepare the draft district development plan keeping in view the matters of common interest between urban and rural population including spatial planning sharing of water and other physical and natural resources, the integrated development of infrastructure and environment conservation, the plans prepared at the grass-root level by the concerned Panchayats and the extent and type of available resources whether financial or otherwise.
- b) to prepare priority-wise list of schemes and programmes taking into account the resources available with the Committee and the resources provided by the State Government.
- c) to take appropriate measures for proper implementation of the development schemes, programmes and projects.
- d) to monitor the progress of projects.
- e) to encourage the Panchayats and the Municipalities to take up and expedite the implementation of development projects.
- f) to make efforts to generate additional resources for development works with the cooperation of people. Non-Government Organizations and Non- Resident Indians and other agencies; and
- g) to perform such other additional functions relating to District Planning and Coordination and monitoring of the activities of different departments of the State Government, as may be assigned to the Committee by the State Government.

(2) While preparing the draft development plan, the Committee may consult such institutions and organizations, as may be specified by the State Government from time to time.

(3) The Chairperson shall forward the district development plans prepared by the Committee under clause (a) of sub-section (1) to the State Government.

- 6.** With effect from the date, the Committees are constituted under this Act, the existing District Planning and Development Boards in the State shall cease to function.

Meetings

- 7.** (1) In the transaction of its business, the Committee shall follow such procedure, as may be prescribed.
- (2) If on account of any reason, the Chairperson is unable to attend the meeting of the Committee, any other member, chosen by the present members, shall preside over the meeting.
- (3) The meeting of the Committee shall be held at the District Head Quarters or at such place, as may be decided by the Committee.

- 8.** (1) The State Government may remove the Chairperson or any member from his office, if:-
- a) he has been adjudged insolvent; or
 - b) he has been convicted of an offence which, in the opinion of the State Government, involves moral turpitude; or
 - c) he has become physically or mentally incapable; or
 - d) he has acquired such financial or other interest, as is likely to affect prejudicially his functions in any of the said capacities; or
 - e) he has so abused his position as to render his continuance in office prejudicial to the public interest.
- (2) Before removing any member including the Chairperson from his office, a reasonable opportunity of being heard shall be given to him by the State Government.
- 9.** If any vacancy occurs, it shall be filled up from the same source from which it has occurred.
- 10.** The State Government may, from time to time, issue such directions to the Committees, as it may consider appropriate in public interest.
- 11.** (1) The State Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, make rules for carrying out the purposes of this Act.
- (2) Every rule made under this Act, shall be laid, as soon as may be, after it is made, before the House of the State Legislature, while it is in session, for a total period of ten days, which may be comprised in one session or in two or more successive sessions, and if, before the expiry of the session in which it is so laid or the successive sessions as aforesaid, the House agrees in making any modification in the rule or the house agrees, that the rule should not be made, the rule shall thereafter have effect only in such modified form or be of no effect, as the case may be, so however that any such modification or annulment shall be without prejudice to the validity of anything previously done or omitted to be done under that rule.

12. (1) If any difficulty arises in giving effect to any of the provisions of this Act, the State Government may, by an order published in the Official Gazette, make such provisions not inconsistent with the provisions of this act, as may appear to it to be necessary for removing the difficulty. Provided that no such order shall be made under this section after the expiry of a period of two years from the date of the commencement of this act.

(2) Every order made under this section, shall be laid, as soon as may be, after it is made, before the Punjab Legislative Assembly.
